

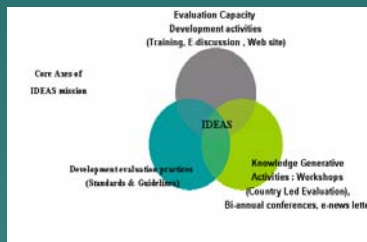


INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT EVALUATION ASSOCIATION

BACKGROUND:

In May 2001 a meeting of more than 40 development evaluation professionals was held in London from which resulted the 'London Declaration on the Establishment of IDEAS' on May 8th 2001 to fill up a gap identified by these professionals. IDEAS was then launched on September 8th 2002 in Beijing with formal lodgement of Memorandum and Articles of Association with the Charities Commission in the UK in February 2003.

MISSION: The advancement of education for the *public benefit* in the *theories, methods and practice* of evaluation in order to improve and expand *the capacity* for understanding and standards of evaluation *predominantly* in developing countries.



The Constitution give a clear and appropriate set of powers that encompass the kinds of activities , such as : to award annual prizes & award scholarships; to make grants; to organize meetings, lectures, conferences, broadcasts or courses of instruction; to produce, publish and distribute or to make grants towards the cost of others producing, publishing or distributing material that may be deemed desirable.
