## Alignment and Result-Orientation

### OVERVIEW

#### Aim:

- position the development program 2007-2012 of a small bilateral donor in the development context of Mongolia
- build on national strategies in compliance with the Paris Declaration

### HIGHLIGHTS

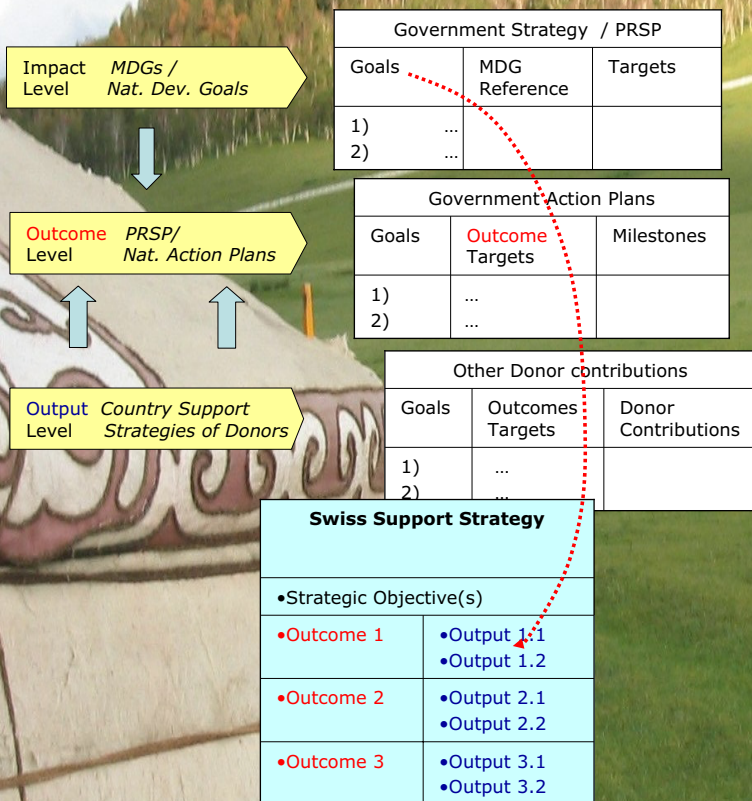
- compliance with national policy papers by directly linking SDC program to policy papers
- link of cooperation strategy to annual implementation (objectives SCS, results 2006 and planning 2007 together in one table)
- result-orientation emphasized in program
- program management structure revised in order to better deliver development results

### RESULTS

SDC strategic program framework (table 1) is related to monitoring tables (2-4)

(see Handout for details)

- table 2 monitoring of the context
- table 3 monitoring of the country outcome and SDC strategic objective
- table 4 monitoring of SDC outputs



### LESSONS LEARNT

- Formulation of contents for monitoring tables is challenging as information summarizes inputs from various projects at a meta/ meso level (i.e. cannot directly be deducted from project reports)
- Monitoring system gives good overview for program steering in view of reaching targets at different levels
